

New Attribute to RBC Prepare to Transfuse Order

Attention Ordering Providers:

- A new special requirement has been added to the RBC Prepare to Transfuse order to identify patients with sickle cell disease who require hemoglobin S-negative units.
- Please check **"Sickle Cell (Hgb S) Negative"** when ordering blood components for patients with sickle cell disease to ensure appropriate RBC matching to reduce alloimmunization risk.
- All RBC prepare to transfuse orders for patients with sickle cell disease must have this special requirement added. If not selected, Transfusion Service Staff will request a new order.
- This update will go live on Tuesday August 18!
